Health-Careers Exploration Summer Institute (HESI)

HESI is a three-week summer institute that provided 13 students from Eureka High, Arcata High, McKinleyville High and Six Rivers Charter High the opportunity to explore healthcare careers through participation in clinical rotations, class time and homework. The summer 2017 institute ran from July 10 through July 27.
